

## **Job Description**

**Job Title: Certified Welder**

### **Summary:**

Perform construction and welding duties on a daily basis ensuring quality installations, per Customer.

### **Essential Duties and Responsibilities:**

- Perform basic tower and ground work as required.
- Welding from ground level to 400 feet in the air.
- Assist Supervisor and crew in all aspects of installations.
- Reports to Field Supervisor.
- Other duties as assigned.

### **Physical Demands:**

- Ability to hear, understand and direct crewmembers to carryout instructions.
- Standing, walking, climbing 90% of the day.
- Ability to stoop, bend, reach and carry, and handle materials weighing 75 pounds.
- Ability to comfortably climb and work at required heights.

### **Work Environment:**

- Construction tasks performed with exposure to outdoor weather conditions.
- Risk of electrical shock and radiation.
- Work near mechanical parts.
- Loud noise levels such as produced by construction equipment.
- May work at heights and in precarious places.

### **Qualifications, Certificates, License, Registrations:**

- Requires a thorough knowledge of welding practices and techniques, equipment types, purposes and applications, and material characteristics.
- Knowledge of the AWS, ANSI, and ASME codes.
- Must be able to bring all welding certifications for review.
- Must be able to perform essential duties and responsibilities, meet physical demands and work comfortably in the work environment.
- Must be able to read and interpret drawings and documents such as operating instructions, drawings, and safety signage.
- High School Diploma, GED, or equivalent desired.
- Valid driver's license desired.
- Pass N.A.T.E. "Tower Climber Orientation" exam.
